With a sigh of relief, we look ahead from the cataclysmic years which have thankfully receded. The healing time of today is giving us all the confidence to plan for the forgotten 'normal'.

The past year centred on new spaces, literal and figurative. The Playground got a new face with generous donations from well-wishers and donors from overseas. This translated into an extension of the ground and new seating capacity. The support made it possible to hold the 25th Sports Day at Akshar, a landmark in more ways than one.

The Early Intervention supported by FLO (FICCI Ladies Organisation) gave Akshar a toehold in the villages towards the West. Children were identified, parents counselled and a significant number of new students entered the portals.

Adaptation of Text is gathering pace with new support. A charming new project is the illustration of a children's storybook by 6 students. This is for an author based in the US. A small vocational unit has been offered by the Government. This will be headed by one of our alumni who has a B.Sc. (Hons.) with Major in Textiles & Apparel Design.

As has been said, one can become disabled by falling off one's polo pony or by having a poor diet in one's childhood. We are all vulnerable. This was forcefully brought home to me recently when my mother needed to use a wheelchair because of a mild stroke. I could not take her to most places in Vadodara as prestigious film theatres & auditoriums have no provisions for wheelchairs. Whether it is physical access or educational inclusion, the sign that people with disability encounter most often is - 'Out of bounds!'

Message from the Principal

Dear All

2022-23 proved to be an interesting year with many different facets.

2 Android panel boards with advanced features were installed in two classes, which brings the number of Smart Classes to 12. Training was provided to all educators.

With the support of United Way of Baroda, games coaches from Baroda Football Academy began, once again, to start coaching in football, cricket, badminton, etc. An under-13 Akshar football team played for the first time in the interschool matches.

Association of People with Disability (APD),

Bengaluru gave a valuable donation of 54 digital hearing aids and moulds. Three audiologists came from Bengaluru to spend 3 days at Akshar. The MOU signed with Sumandeep Vidyapeeth University became fruitful as a team of audiologists took ear mould impressions of more than 60 students. This was in tandem with the work of APD. From January 2023 onwards, batches of audiologists are coming to intern at Akshar.

NCERT (National Council of Educational Research & Training) proposed a Sign Language Standardization project to Akshar in November 2022. Only a few organisations in India were approached for this work.

Videos of signs used at Akshar were prepared under the guidance of the Principal and 3 months were spent. There were no free classes for teachers during the project. Akshar uploaded 1038 signs on the portal which was the highest number in the chosen groups across the country.

For whom does Akshar work?

For children with sensorineural deafness.

Nearly all belong to the economically weaker section of society. Many parents are not educated but believe in the value of education.

The experience of nearly 35 years has shown us that given the appropriate pedagogy, technology and opportunity, a child with deafness can, and does perform as well as the child without deafness. This is the belief that drives our work.

We believe.

Children with deafness are children first.

They have rights to

- Happy Childhood
- Literacy
- Communication Skills & Livelihood

Right to all the above notwithstanding the fact that they belong to the poorer and more underprivileged section of society.

Overview

Akshar Trust began its work with 5 hearing impaired/deaf children on 18th July 1988 in a small, rented shed in Fatehsinghrao Gymkhana. Today, it is educating 98 children with a staff of 27, including special educator's teachers, an audiologist, & a speech pathologist, faculty members, consultants, an art teacher, a karate teacher, teacher's aides, interns, voluntary workers, bus drivers and other staff.

Experience over the past 35 years has shown Akshar that given the correct pedagogy, technology and opportunity, a child with deafness can and does perform as well as the next child without deafness. This is the belief that drives our work.




As a not-for-profit, secular, charitable trust, it has worked to provide hearing-impaired children an opportunity to be educated and thus be employed and independent.

Coverage

Children come to Akshar for education from different places in and outside Vadodara. They have come to Vadodara from Shinor, Padra, Chhota Udepur, Anand, Kalol, Bharuch, Halol, Dabhoi, Waghodia, Sadhali, etc. Some come from Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh.



Our Activities

A hearing child develops speech and forms basic language concepts in the critical age of 0-3 years. So, for a child with deafness the training process should start immediately upon diagnosis.



Effective Educational Activities

Early Intervention

Akshar Centre was the first in Gujarat to have started an Early Intervention programme in 1978 before the formal center took shape. In this programme, the youngest child has been 3 months. Interaction with hospitals, Anganwadi's, and orphanages has ensured that children with deafness are identified earlier.

Working with Amplification Devices

Audiologists and teachers work with the students regularly. All the equipment required for amplification is available. Free hearing aids are distributed to the more needy students through the support of other organizations.

Videography & Film

Videos of the classroom- teaching for discussion and constructive feedback on the improvement of teaching methodology are made. A film on Total Communication was produced by Akshar for the Rehabilitation Council of India. Visiting students from China made videos on the 'Sign Dictionary'.

Adaptation

Adaptation of Curriculum and Textbooks has been done in tune with principles of special education, since 2005. This is undertaken by very few organizations in the country.

Technology

Paul Mason Consulting India Pvt. Ltd. (PMC) had designed software for 'Students' Management' for Akshar. PPT Presentations are used both for teaching trainees and students. Teachers make videos as per the curriculum. There are 12 Smart Boards in the classes of which 11 were donated by PMC and 1 was donated by Indian Oil Corporation. Laptops have also been donated by PMC and Mr. Daxesh Patel.

On-going Programmes & Plans

Continuing Rehabilitation Education (CRE)

Akshar has conducted 20 CRE programmes under the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) to date. Special educators, including principals and vice-principals from Gujarat and Mumbai, have attended lectures on deafness and teaching methodology.



Buses

3 buses were donated by ONGC (Oil and Natural Gas Corporation), State Bank of India and Koch Glitsch; a division of Koch Chemicals. These buses help our students, trainees, and staff on a daily basis.



New Infrastructure

Akshar has developed facilities at the new building.

Playground and Games



- The playground and other facilities have been made possible due to the generous donations given by various organisations. The initial amount received from United Way of Baroda helped in building the playground and equipping the facility; the funding by GACL contributed towards the multipurpose Court; the Games Coaches sent by GSFC helped the students improve their skills in various games and sports. United Way of Baroda has continued its valuable funding.
- The availability of proper equipment and training resulted in the students participating in the Khel Mahakumbh (Games Competition) of Vadodara District with some getting awards. The students have consistently been participating and achieving in games at 'Prerna', organized by M.S. University for Children with Disabilities.
- The retaining wall for the playground was built by Mini and Jagdeep Budhiraja. This protects the students from the Mini River which flows just below.
- DCB Bank has contributed a drainage system and a Water-Harvesting tank at the playground level. This helps in soil retention.

Karate

The students have been learning Karate since 1995. They have mastered many techniques, earned various 'belts' and participated in many competitions in the city under the guidance of Mr. James George. As Mr. George says, 'Akshar is concentrating on the overall development of the students to face their difficulties by training them mentally and physically. Mostly all the students are interested in martial art, are very good at Karate and doing well'.



Art

Under the guidance of Mr. Jaydev Biswal, all the students are learning drawing and painting. Special teaching techniques have been developed to make them understand better. There is a separate Art Room with specially designed tables, a big LED screen, a blackboard and large display boards. Akshar provides all the art materials. Students learn drawing using different techniques and application of different mediums of colour. Most of them are good at drawing and painting. They have received several awards in National and State level Art Competitions. This year they competed with regular children of schools in Baroda and got 1st, 2nd and 4th prizes in different groups.

Some of the alumni have graduated from the famous Faculty of Fine Arts.

Cost Effectiveness Free Accommodation Since 1991 Akshar has managed the work in buildings but without paying rent. 1988-91 a rented shed in Fatehsinh Gymkhana Paul Mason Consulting donated old office furniture. This formed the backbone of the school furniture on the new campus in 2016. 1991-96 EME wing of the army gave a small bungalow under the Army Welfare Organisation. 1996-2016 The Municipal School Board (ShikshanSamiti) permitted the use of various empty schools. In 2000, the Govt. of Gujarat leased Akshar 2 1/2 acres of 'Kothar', 'Wasteland' on the outskirts of Vadodara city. After 16 years of great efforts by all trustees, including fighting a case with a squatter, the new campus was inaugurated on April 29, 2016, by Dr J. N. Singh, ex-Chief Secretary, Govt. of Gujarat. This year scholarships for 47 students were organized

Akshar arranges to get scholarships from the Govt. of Gujarat for students coming from a poor economic background. Recycling of paper and cards - All-rough work in school is done on used paper collected from offices and homes.

Interactions

Noteworthy Individuals who have mentored and guided Akshar include Ms. Mandira Banerji, Dr. Bharatiben Modi, Ms.Tehmina Cawasji, Dr. Prabha Ghate, Ms. Mini Budhiraja, Gen. Bobby Dutta, Dr. Varsha Gathoo and Mr. Karan Grover among others.

Through the years, many organisations, both Indian & foreign, have been involved with Akshar and have sent volunteers.

AISEC and International Youth Volunteer Service,

Germany are among them.

Dr. Prabha Ghate was responsible for Akshar to choose Total Communication as a mode of communication in 1996.

Ms. Kristine Landon-Smith, a well-known theatre personality and her husband, Mr. Felix Cross, MBE, an international music composer, from the UK, shared their expertise. They conducted workshops for the students in 2018. This was the second visit for Ms. Landon-Smith. Subsequently, Ms. Kristine conceived and directed a 'Short Long Film' on Zoom. Mr. Felix Cross composed the music.

Ms. Suchitra Parikh & Ms. Neena Arora, who run Page to Stage, have involved students of Akshar over many years. Beginning with a Play about Cricket, written by Akshar students, an experimental film was made on Zoom during COVID-19 times. This has been nominated on 4 film platforms. The cast has won an award on one film platform.

Ms. Sophie Williams, a speech pathologist from the UK spent time at Akshar in 2017. Two young girls from Germany, Ms. Anne Schramm and Ms. Sophie Aschbrenner taught English to the students, most successfully, for a year. Ms. Aleyna Brandt worked for a month in 2019. She has also been sponsoring a student.

NGO Expo

Liveweek Business invited Ms. N. Grover to participate in the 9th Global Conference in New York in September 2018. Mr. Girish Mehta a donor of Akshar from the USA, trustee of VVCT and a well-wisher of Akshar, extended all the possible help at the Expo.

Ms. Rupande Valera and her daughter, Vaidehi, who lives in the USA, volunteered at the Expo. They are related to Manan Patel, one of Akshar's earliest students, now working in the USA.

Akshar was also featured in the 'Good Book' brought out by Liveweek.

In July 2019, Akshar participated in the NGO Expo in Mumbai.



Skill Development

- In 2017, a unique model for Skill Development was sponsored by Paul Mason Consulting India Pvt. Ltd. (PMC), a U.K.-based corporate. A development agency was asked to conduct 6month courses exclusively for Akshar alumni. Drop-outs were also included. PMC has been employing Akshar alumni for the past 14 years.
- PMC is supporting 2 new initiatives:
- a) a special English teacher to enhance the English language of Akshar students from Std. 3 to Std. 8.
- b) supporting the upgrading of the English skills of 6 alumni working at PMC.
- Further plans for skill development are being explored by PMC.
- The Govt. of India has initiated a Skill
 Development model for young people with
 disability. Akshar Trust has been chosen as a
 centre to conduct a garment design and
 tailoring unit.



Teacher Training

The Teacher Training Department started in 1993 and is conducted in both Hindi and Gujarati. The D.Ed. Spl. Ed. (HI) course was recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI), a statutory body governed by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment in 1999 for a 2-year course.

429 teachers have been trained till now and 37 are in the process of completing their course for diploma.

Under RCI Akshar also started offering an Advanced Certificate course of 6 months in 'Inclusive Education - Cross Disabilities', as a pilot project for RCI. This began in February 2018 with 40 candidates and concluded in the same year. This was the third teacher training course undertaken by Akshar.

Capacity Building

NCED-India - Vadodara Conference 2020

For over 19 years, Akshar Trust has been keenly involved in the work of National Convention of Educators of Deaf-India (NCED-India). NCED-India is a national-level association of special educators and allied members working to upgrade the skills of educators of children with hearing impairment, the inception of which dates to 1935. There are 9 State Chapters, an Annual Peer Reviewed Journal since 2009 and National and International Conferences which have been held across the country annually.

Akshar was represented at the national level by Ms. Nisha Grover as Vice-President from 2006. She took over as President in 2010 and after completing 2 terms stepped down in 2016 at the Mysore Conference. The Gujarat Chapter is presently headed by Ms. Hema Kale who is also on the Governing Council of NCED-India as the Assistant Secretary. Grass root work through Continuing Rehabilitation Education workshops & annual conferences have been the hallmark of the body.



NCED - Gujarat Chapter

The Gujarat Chapter of NCED-India was formed in 2004 and Akshar Trust, Vadodara became the head office. Since the formation of this chapter, Akshar has been the nodal body for NCED -Gujarat and 2 members of Akshar Trust have always been actively engaged in the work. In 2005, a national-level conference was organized at Vadodara, where 22 papers were presented for 350 participants. Dr. I. G. Patel, former Governor, Reserve Bank of India, former Director, London School of Economics was the Chief Guest and Mr. Philip O'Keefe, Lead Social Protection Specialist for India, World Bank, was the keynote speaker. Apart from the first national conference at Vadodara in 2005, 7 State conferences have been organized: first at Nadiad, 2011, with 139 participants; second at Himatnagar, 2012, with 156 participants; third at Nadiad, with 300 participants, Awards for Best Papers were introduced during this conference; fourth at Nadiad, December 2015 with 283 participants.; the fifth conference was at Vadodara, December 2016 with 205 participants; the sixth conference at Bhavnagar December 2017, with 153 participants; and the seventh at Navsari in 2018.

The 85th NCED India National Conference was organized at Vadodara in February 2020.

Games Coaching supported by United Way of Baroda

On July 04, 2022, Ms. Neelam Acharya from United Way of Baroda, visited, as a Proposal to support Games Coaching for students had been made. The project was accepted and 3 coaches from Baroda Football Academy (BFA) are now coming twice a week. They teach Football, Cricket, Basketball and Badminton. The students 'Drew' a Match on February 11, 2023, in 'Under 13 yrs. Football Match' at Baroda Football Academy against a BFA team.

Early intervention supported by FLO (FICCI Ladies Organization)

In the Shark Tank in April 2022, FLO most generously raised funds to support Early Intervention. Under this project, villages close to Akshar are visited, children with disability are identified and parents are involved more closely. The funds from FLO support this project for 2 years. 2 special educators are involved.

MOU with Sumandeep University



Sumandeep Vidyapeeth University signed an MOU with Akshar on 15th July 2022. Various programmes have since taken place:

Ear Mould Impressions

Students from the institute came to take hearing aid mould impressions of 55 students of Akshar, December 08 & 09, 2022. The students were accompanied by Mr. Y. Prasad, audiologist & speech-language pathologist cum ear mould technician. These impressions were sent to Bengaluru for the APD (Association of People with Disabilities) to bring the moulds for distribution on December 24, 2022.



Audiograms

On December 21, 2022, 18 Akshar students went to Sumandeep's Audiology Dept. for audiograms, which were done for free.

Internship

February 28, 2023, 5 Audiologists from Sumandeep did their internship at Akshar from January to April 2023.



Akshar at a Symposium

An Annual National Symposium was organized by the Consortium for Inclusive Education on 'Inclusion in Math Education, a way to think differently about differences', on September 23, 2022. Akshar had a stall at the Symposium, managed by the Coordinator, Ms. V. Patel, and 2 trainees. Posters on deafness, the work of students, teaching strategies etc. were exhibited. Several signs of Indian Sign Language, for greetings, for family members etc., along with finger-spelling were demonstrated to visitors.

Standardization of Sign Language

An interesting new project of ISLRTC (Indian Sign Language Research & Training Centre) & NCERT (National Council of Educational Research & Training) began on October 21, 2022. Akshar Trust has been chosen as one of the centers in India for the project, 'Standardisation of Sign Language'. The standardisation pertains to a list of words sent by NCERT and the signs for these words in use at Akshar.

By the end of 3 months, the work was complete for 1038 words.

Towards this work video recordings, training given to 5 deaf students, editing of each video, uploading on YouTube, the NCERT portal and the making of new signs were undertaken.

Akshar completed the 1038 signs for NCERT.

Under the supervision of the principal, Ms. H. Kale; lecturer, Mr. D. Patadia; teachers, Ms. R. Khan, Ms. D. Dindorkar, Ms. N. Sevak, Ms. V. Patel, Ms. C. Gandhi; and the Computer Operator; Mr. J. Shajimon were involved.

Distribution of Hearing Aids & Moulds



With the support of Mr. Sanjay Kumar, Deputy Director & Officer in Charge, Indian Sign Language Research & Training (ISLRTC), **Association of People with Disabilities** (APD), Bengaluru, offered to give Digital Programmable hearing aids and moulds to 54 students of Akshar. Three members of APD, Audiologist; Ms. N.A. Mathew; Ms. S. N. Killikyatyar, and Dr. M.K. Muniyan were present for 3 days. They programmed the hearing aids for each student. Sumandeep Vidyapeeth University had made the mould impressions to be sent to Bengaluru and did free audiograms for some students. Akshar had paid for travel from Bengaluru for the 3 persons. With the help of Mr. Sanjay Kumar, other well-wishers had extended hospitality.



The distribution was done by Mr. Chaitanya Desai, MLA, Akota on December 24, 2022.


